Course objectives:

This course requires intermediate knowledge of source language with respect to the topic of dissertation project. It may be dead as well as modern language. The status of source language proposes supervisor and it is a subject to the approval of the programe council.

Requirements on student

The exam is to prove the language level of the graduate in the following areas:

1. Reading a professional text with understanding.
2. Written capture and oral formulation of the main ideas of the read text.
3. Critical translation of the text

Required documents:

- a) a summary of 50 pages of the studied authentic professional text in the source language (3 pages in Czech),
- b) a dictionary of terminology from the studied text in the source language of the doctoral student's field (150 terms),
- c) own translation of 10 pages of the selected text in the source language (3-5 pages).

The doctoral student is obliged to submit all materials submitted for the examination to the assigned workplace no later than 2 weeks before the examination.

Content

This course requires intermediate knowledge of English. It is assigned for Ph.D. students of the Faculty of Arts who have chosen English as a second foreign language. Students will develop skills in writing abstracts, reading and understanding authentic and professional texts in English, listening comprehension and oral presentation.
